Project Overview

Hollywood Boulevard is a thriving commercial corridor. It runs through several diverse communities including Little Armenia and Thai Town, has many pedestrians and bicyclists, and provides access to several bus lines and subway stations. However, there has been a pattern of serious crashes - 56 people were killed or severely injured between 2010 and 2019 along a 2-mile segment of Hollywood between Gower Street and Lyman Place. This has led LADOT to prioritize this street for traffic safety improvements. Over the coming months, LADOT will engage the community and local stakeholders as we work to create a safer street for everyone, especially people who walk, bike and take transit.
