

PROJECT DESCRIPTION

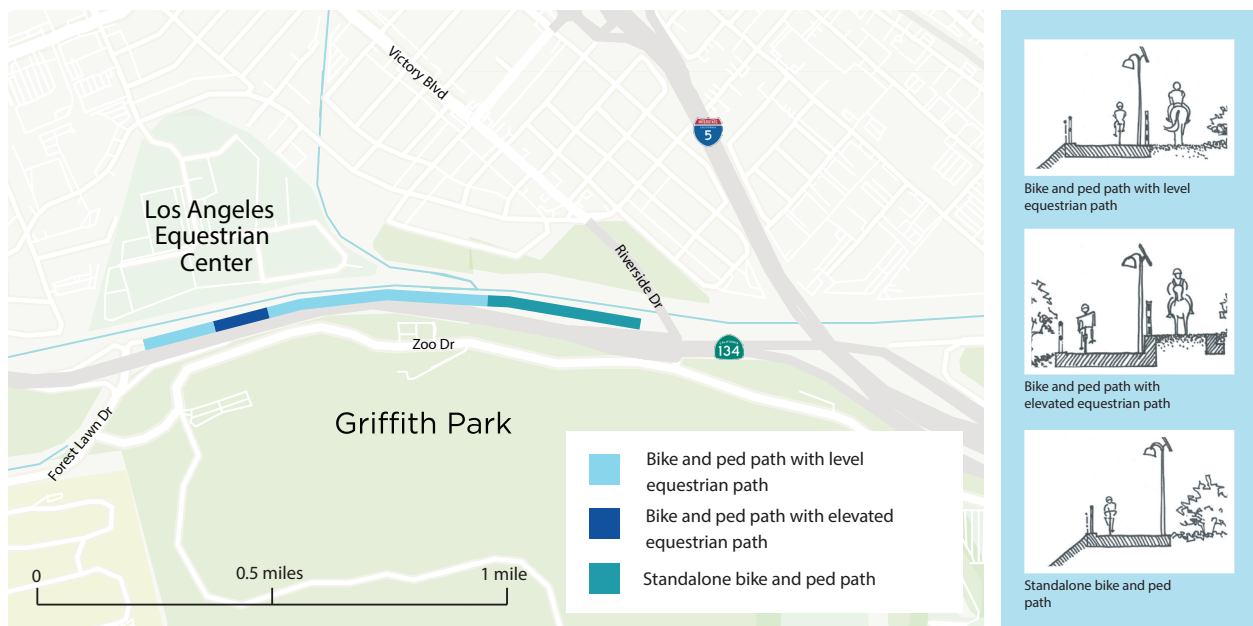
The LA Riverway Path travels 7 miles from Elysian Valley (Barclay St) on the south end to Griffith Park (Riverside Dr) on the north end. This project will extend the existing LA Riverway Path by 1 mile on the northern portion of Griffith Park, from Riverside Dr to just east of the CA-134 Forest Lawn Dr on and off ramps. The bike and pedestrian path will only be accessible from Riverside Drive. Additionally, the LA Riverway Phase IV project will construct a partially separated equestrian trail alongside the bike and pedestrian path. The proposed equestrian path will connect the LA Equestrian Center to a Griffith Park trail via an equestrian tunnel.

The project is currently in the design phase, and we are aiming to complete design and gain environmental clearance by Summer 2024. We anticipate construction starting Spring 2025 and completing by Spring 2028.

PROJECT FEATURES

- This project rehabilitates an existing maintenance road into a finished asphalt path for recreation.
- It will add a new path serving cyclists and pedestrians, with a partially separated trail for equestrians.
- The completed project will also include lighting, paint striping, signage, and potentially landscaping.
